

Who Can Enter

Any multidisciplinary PICU/LSU team that is a fully paid member of NAPICU.

How to Enter

Write a total of no more than 1500 words to cover:

- The unit: population demography, resources, staffing, and any research.
- The team: philosophy and policy, main members and roles, evidence of achievements.
- Improvements and innovation: highlight what difference these have made.
- How the National Minimum Standards have affected provision of services.
- An appendix may also include a copy of the Unit Operational Policy.

Judging Criteria

Judges will shortlist teams upon written entries. The short listed teams will be invited to showcase their unit for 10 minutes in a parallel workshop at the National Conference in York, September 2010. The winning team will be announced at the NAPICU Conference Dinner and receive £500 to spend on their service.

Each entry will be judged on objective evidence of the following criteria:

- Achievements within the past year
- Evidence of service improvements
- User contribution to services
- Use of available resources
- Realistic and achievable planned developments to the service/team
- Evidence of team working and the liaison with others (both intra- and inter agency)
